The H2 (hydro) car reached a distance of 280 km per litre and the battery car reached 206 km per litre.


H2 (Hydrogen) car came 1st with 327km/kWh and the Battery Car came 3rd overall with 222km/kWh. Our team came 1st for Safety.

Project Connect posted on Facebook: "I'm not sure that everyone understands what these kids achieved. On their first attempt at a Shell Eco Marathon even with a Hydrogen propelled vehicle, they achieved a result of 327km/m3 of Hydrogen. The

Shell Eco Marathon America event has been going for 10 years of which the Hydrogen Category has been running atleast 3 years. Keep in mind that this is some of the top Universities in the USA and the BEST result achieved in the last 3 years was 151km/m3. These kids were amazing. To top it all, they won the HSSC (Health and Safety) Award for the 3rd year in a row. You are truly an amazing group of Scientists and it was a privilege and an honor to work with you".
