- 4. Discernment,

## Why pray for these, you may ask?

- Because love is supreme, and from love flows all good things. After all, God is love.
- Knowledge, and not just knowing a few things, but a deep and intimate knowledge, a life-changing and life-directing knowledge. In the original Greek of the New Testament, either the word gnosis or epignosis was used to convey knowledge, but with a different intensity - the first, gnosis, referred to a general knowledge and the second, epignosis, referred to a comprehensive, personal knowledge. That's what we pray for.
- Depth of insight, that ability to call God's revelation to mind when needed and to grasp the mysteries that he shows us.
- Discernment, or street-smarts, maybe. We live in a culture where very few practice discernment. Instead people are making important decisions on the basis of impulsivity, emotion or instant gratification. Lord, give us discernment.
- Purity, a great gift to desire. "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God", say the Beattitudes.

"This is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ - to the glory and praise of God." Philippians 1:9-11
