I would love to see our graduates characterised by three qualities: Incarnational Leadership, Redemptive Purpose and Missional Community. This week we'll look at Incarnational Leadership. In South Africa, our school curriculum concentrates way too much on good leadership. We should be teaching kids about good followership. This is what Jesus modelled for us. He regularly says things like "I do nothing except what I've seen the Father do before me" and "I finished the work that you (the Father) gave me to do". Out of his obedient following, his leadership flowed.

In the Jewish culture, there is a blessing that says "may the dust of your rabbi stick to you". In other words, may you follow so close behind that his dust covers you. We are training our students to follow Jesus like that, and as Jesus 'dust' sticks to them, that they will be influencers and leaders out of that.

The word Christian was coined to describe the followers of the Way in the early church of the book of Acts. It literally means 'little Christ' and does not in dicate followers who are deities, but rather followers who strive to lead and influence exactly as Jesus did. May we not only teach Incarnational Leadership to our kids, but may our teachers also model Incarnational Leadership in their daily lives. We are desperate for God's Holy Spirit to empower this process. "I pray that out of his glorious riches, God may strengthen you with power in your inner being by His Spirit, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith".






Congratulations to the u/15 Boys that ended 11th out of 16 schools in their section and the 1st Team finished 8th out of 16 schools.


