CAN YOUR CHILD MAKE A SANDWICH?

1. Our Intermediate Phase kids prepared sandwiches to take along to Orient Hills for outreach. Teacher Angie reports that many of the children did not know how to spread butter on the bread, and asked her to show them how.

2. Teacher Claire explained that a large proportion of the kids in Primary School were unable to hop, skip or balance. They fall over or stumble when attempting a simple movement.

3. Our Foundation Phase produced a beautiful display garden at Garden World. During the setup, Teacher Angie noticed that kids were unsure how to use a paintbrush to paint a wall, or even to dig a small hole to plant out a little shrub from a pot.

4. In the High School Science lab, Mrs. Schoonwinkel tells us that she is finding that kids have no idea how to use common sense around heating liquids or safety with acids.

Our kids are not able to do some simple tasks that we might have grown up doing on a regular basis. They don't get exposed to them because of the myriads of lifestyle changes which are our current reality.

I'd like to appeal to parents to help their kids grow in these areas by working together around the house, playing throw and catch, and assigning age-appropriate chores. Let's equip these kids with life skills.

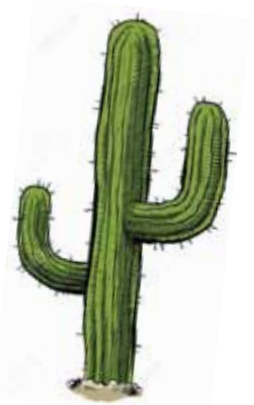

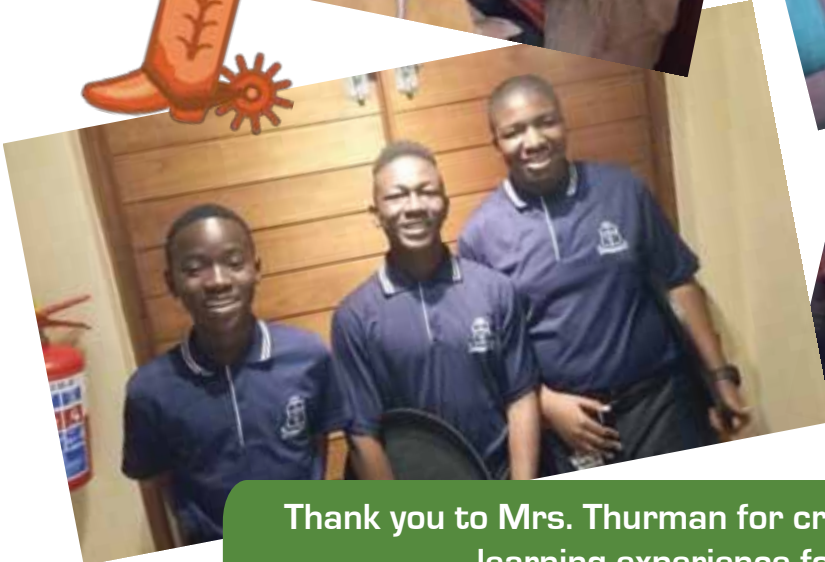


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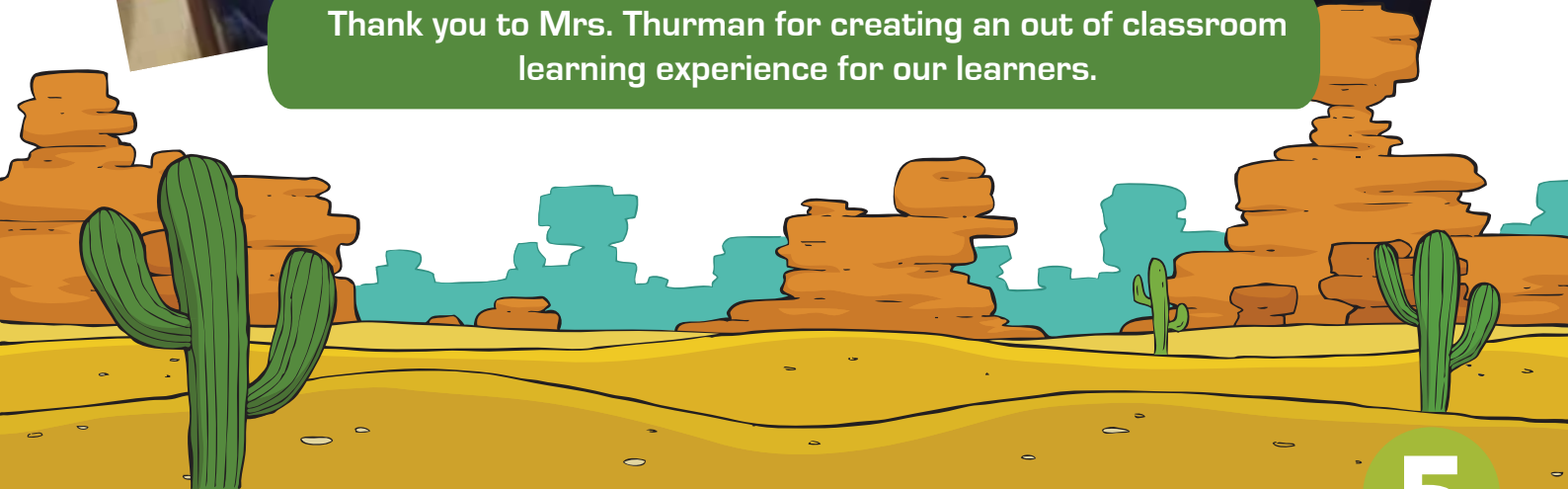
GRADE 7 SPUR EVENING

MINI CRICKET

The King's School West Rand are part of Joburg West Mini Cricket which forms part of Cricket South Africa (CSA). CSA have partnered with KFC to produce Mini Cricketers and future Proteas. The keywords in Mini Cricket are participation and enjoyment. It provides a medium where children can be coached while taking part in a modified game of cricket. The objective of KFC Mini Cricket is to introduce the game to young boys and girls in a simple and fun way. While the emphasis is on fun and enjoyment, it is also important that our young players are taught the right disciplines of batting, bowling and fielding. In its basic form, Mini Cricket consists of fast scaled down games with eight children per team.

We are limited by the number of teams that can participate by the team numbers of the schools we play against. Games last approximately one hour and every child taking part will bat, bowl, keep wicket and field during the course of the match. This prevents the domination of matches by better players and gives everyone an equal opportunity. On Wednesday 23 August 2017 our u7 and u8 Mini Cricket Boys played their first matches of the season at Horizon View Primary School. For some of our boys, it was the first time on a school bus! Very exciting! Despite some teething problems, our little boys had a great time and are looking forward to the rest of the season.

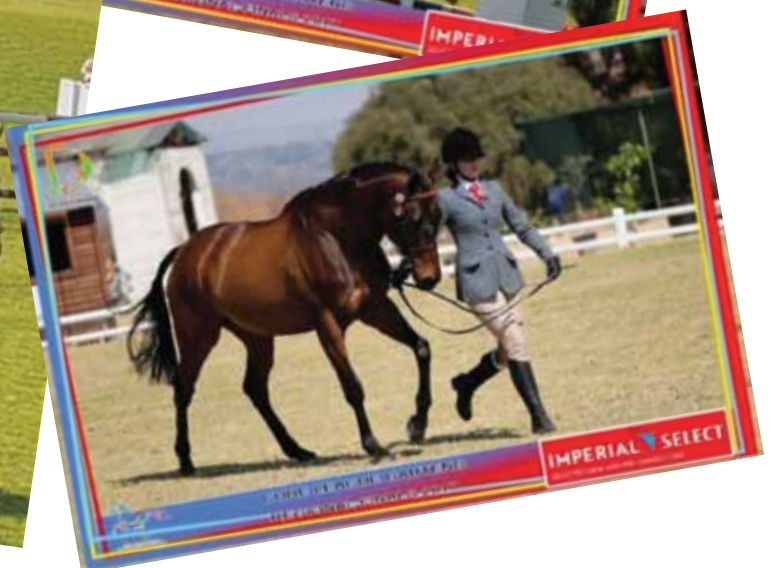

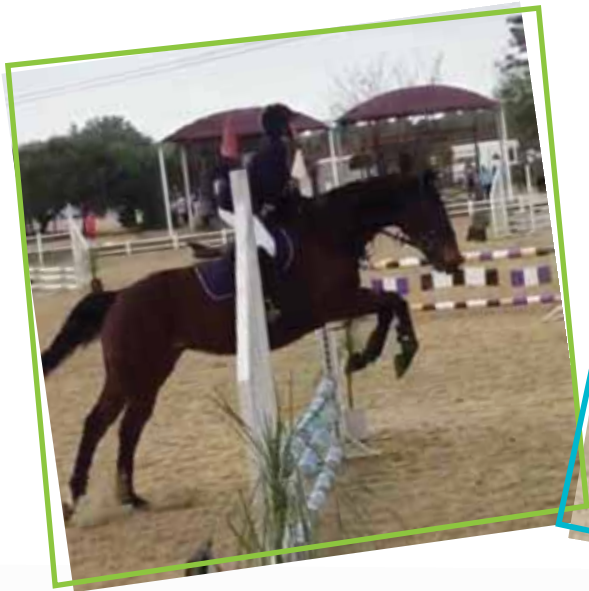
