DEAR PARENTS,

Thank you for your continued support of excellent Christian education to the glory of God. As we all struggle to meet ends in this time of economic difficulties and budget shortfalls, our Board of Directors have worked hard to keep next year's fee increase to the minimum. In fact, it is the lowest annual increase we have had on fees over the last 15 years. The average fee increase for next year is 5,9%.


In addition, we have retained a discount of 9% for fees paid annually in advance by 31 January 2018, meaning that you can qualify for fees that are not only not increased, but actually less than this year's fees!

We have further looked to increase assistance to families with multiple children in our school. Two children family discount has been increased by 33% (R400 off) and three children family discount has been increased by 12,5% (R900 off).

Even though the school's expense lines are projected to increase by 7,6% on next year's budget, we believe that with prudent financial management and prompt paying of fees, we can get by with the reduced fee increase. Parents can assist us by ensuring that fees are paid on time before the 7th of each month, and if possible we are grateful to our parents who can afford to pay annually in advance, as this allows us to settle big expenses early in the year.

Please will you take note of the detailed fee schedule in this King's Ken in order to accurately plan for next year.


