

# WAITING CLASS RULES AND PROCEDURES

**Grade RR and Grade R:** Will be in Teacher supervised waiting area (sandpit area) from 13:00 to 13:30 whereafter they will go to Aftercare and will be entered into the Aftercare at 14:20.

**Grade 1 to Grade 3:** Will be in Teacher supervised waiting class from 13:00 to 13:30. Children will then go to supervised waiting class under the shade netting from 13:30 until 14:15.

**Grade 4 to Grade 7:** Will be in a supervised waiting area under the shade netting until 14:15.

All children from Grade 1 to Grade 7 will go to the waiting area, and then Aftercare from 14:15.

No child is allowed to wait down on the field or in the car park for their transport.

Every child needs to be fetched personally – no hooting for children. This rule is to be strictly enforced. Please inform your transport company of this rule.

#### STARTING TIMES AND ENDING TIMES:

Starting time:

For all students is 07:30.

Parents, please ensure that children are dropped off punctually. A pattern of tardiness with respect to time is a precursor to failure in many other disciplines.

#### Ending times: Pre-school:
