- Encourage your kids to read. This stimulates imagination and builds vocabulary far more than watching a movie online.
- 3 Have a 'data fast' or device-free day. In my house-hold, we ran out of data halfway through December. I think the last half of the month was really beneficial, admittedly with a lot of complaining too!
- 4. Be intentional about setting limits for online

gaming. As I write this, the World Health Organisation (WHO) has just declared addiction to gaming as a listed mental health disorder. And remember, addicts always say "I can stop whenever I want to."

- 5 Shift the narrative in your home from entertainment and pursuit of sensation to service and obedience. God has a calling on our lives as followers of Christ, and it is in these spaces that we find union with Christ and lasting peace and joy.
- 6 Set aside designated times for family conversation, reflection on the day, engagement with Scripture, and prayer. Check devices into a separate room and have eye-to-eye chats.
- Keep devices out of the bedroom at night, and out of study times. And no, kids don't need their device for the calculator function or for music during studying!

Mostly, let's give this issue of online preoccupation our thoughtful attention so that we are not left counting the cost at a later time. May God give us wisdom.


