Our school has a strong focus on leadership development. This is because every Christian is called to leadership - influencing others to live in accordance with the Gospel.

But sometimes leadership is misunderstoodpeople assume it revolves around imposing their innovative ideas on an organisation, and rising to a place of rulership.

We, at TKSWR are instead teaching our students that leadership flows out of our relationship with Jesus as Lord. We are teaching kids about good followership. This is what Jesus modelled for us. He regularly says things like "I do nothing except what I've seen the Father do before me" and "I finished the work that you (the Father) gave me to do". Out of his obedient following of His Father, his leadership flowed. And now, all these years later, out of our obedient following of Jesus, our leadership will flow.

In the Jewish culture, there is a blessing that says "may the dust of your rabbi stick to you". In other words, may you follow so close behind

that the Rabbi's dust will cover you. We are training our students to follow Jesus like that, and as Jesus 'dust' sticks to them that they will be influencers and leaders out of that.

The word Christian was coined to describe the followers of the Way in the early church of the book of Acts. It literally means 'little Christ' and does not indicate followers who are deities, but rather followers who strive to lead and influence exactly as Jesus did.

IMPOSSIBLE! - You may say. True, it is impossible to lead like Jesus in our own strength. Therefore we are desperate for God's Holy Spirit to empower this process.

"I pray that out of his glorious riches, God may strengthen you with power in your inner being by His Spirit, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith". May it be so.


