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Dear Parents

Thank you for your continued support of excellent Christian education to the glory of God. This term has certainly been an exciting one as we have watched our dream of many years - the dream of having a swimming pool at our school, taking shape. God's provision for The King's School West Rand has not just been sufficient, it has been abundant and our hearts continue to be overwhelmed at His goodness towards us! As the board of directors, we are acutely conscious that God has blessed our school so that we may be a blessing to others and we continue to seek ways in which we can impact the lives of students, not only by striving for excellence in education to the Glory of God within our school but also beyond the borders of The King's School West Rand. In Luke 12:48 we read "...When someone has been given much, much will be required in return; and when someone has been entrusted with much even more will be required." May God grant that we continue to be good stewards of all that He has entrusted to our care.

On behalf of the board of directors, it is my great pleasure to welcome Mrs. Dineo Maithufi onto our board. Her financial acumen, experience in governance and most especially her love for Jesus and belief in Christian education will add great value and it is our prayer that her time as a director will be richly blessed.

As we all struggle through what is now a technical recession, our Board of Directors have tried everything to keep next year's fee increase to the minimum. In fact, it is lower than the published increases of similar sized independent schools in our region. The average fee increase for next year is **5,4%**.

In addition, we are offering discounts on advance payments of fees. Not only have we have retained a discount of 9% for fees paid annually in advance by 31 January 2018, but we are also able to discount a 6 months advance payment by 5% and a 3 months advance payment by 3%, provided that the account is not in arrears.

We have further looked to increase assistance to families with multiple children in our school. Two children family discount has been increased by 50% [R600 off, this year it was R400 off) and three children family discount has been increased by 11% [R1000 off, this year it as R900].

Even though the school's expense lines are projected to increase by **9**% on next year's budget, we believe that with prudent financial management and prompt paying of fees, we can get by with the reduced fee increase. Parents can assist us by ensuring that fees are paid on time before the 7th of each month, and if possible we are grateful to our parents who can afford to pay annually in advance, as this allows us to settle big expenses early in the year.

Please will you take note of the detailed fee schedule in this King's Ken in order to accurately plan for next year.

TRAMPOLINE GYMNASTICS






