THE HOPE OF A NEW DAWN

This last weekend I watched the Presidential Inauguration Ceremony. It was delightful, inspiring and meaningful. My favourite moment was when Chief Justice Mogoeng Mogoeng gave the President a Bible (seemingly unscripted in the programme) and President Ramaphosa gave it back briefly, asking the Chief Justice to personally inscribe the front cover.

25 years ago at his own inauguration, President Mandela said, "We have triumphed in our efforts to implant hope in the breasts of the millions of our people." On Saturday, it was again palpable that there was hope in our country for the "new dawn". As people of God, we remind ourselves that we have hope in our breasts, not for this President or for his party or for his government, or for that matter in any of the almost 50 political parties we may voted for, but our hope is in Jesus, "to whom all authority in heaven and earth has been given" (Matt 28:18).

The new government and all the other parties represented in parliament will surely disappoint us from time to time, but we do

well to remember that our hope is in Jesus and the "government shall be upon his shoulders, and his name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" (Is 9:6).

I am also reminded that the Bible tells us that those in positions of authority have been placed there by God. Romans 13 says, "The authorities are God's servants, sent for your good" (v4) and we should "give respect and honour to those who are in authority" (v7). Incredibly, these words were written originally about a Roman government that was exceedingly oppressive and cruel, and especially so towards the "followers of the Way", the early Christian church.

I am praying for God to have mercy on our people and to raise up God-fearing servants in every party and in positions of authority to lead us into the future. And regardless of the leaders that come and go, trusting that God will direct the course of our nation.


