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### >> Welcome to Term 4 «

My encouragement to our students in term 4 is borrowed from the title of a Bob Buford book - Finishing Well. It's a short term, with only a month or so of instructional time before exams in the intermediate phase and high school.

Here are some tips for you to help your kids finish strong:

- 1. Stay focused. Gregory Boyle in his book "Tattoos on the Heart" says that when Christ said "small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it" he was not referring to restriction but to focus. We need to have a commitment to focus in order to finish the race strong.
- 2. Reflect. Creating summaries of school work helps what we call 'embedding' in the learning process. It's a great tool to enhance long term storage in our minds.
- 3. Practice makes perfect. This particularly important in a subject like Maths where repeated practice will 'concretise' concepts so that your child can develop Maths fluency.
- 4. Exam readiness. Kids sometimes 'know their work' but lack exam readiness. This leads to exam anxiety and performance. Mock exams, trial exams, sample questions or open book tests can all help kids get exam ready. Parents can help by not allowing kids to give up too guickly to check the answer, and by timing the exercise

- 5. Forward planning. Those that fail to plan will plan to fail. I encourage all kids from Intermediate Phase upwards to prepare (and keep to!) a study roster. Let them put their study roster up on the fridge so mom and dad can hold them accountable.
- 6. Consistency is key. Working at a steady pace rather than cramming at the end is always more effective, and creates a great discipline that will bear even more fruit in later years when the volumes of material increase
- 7. Ask lots of questions. Let your child know that his teachers are always available to him/her. If the teachers are occupied with others at the time your child needs them, ask your child to make an appointment with them after school or at break
- 8. Pray. It may sound cheesy to pray for success in exams (especially if one has not prepared adequately!), but praying for a clear mind, perseverance in studying, peace in one's spirit and a fresh understanding of difficult concepts are all beneficial.

As we anticipate the end of the year, may it be with a grateful heart for what God has given us this year.

All reports in the future will be available to be downloaded from ADAM, by parents who have created an account and are logged in to ADAM.

Parents will also be able to re-download past reports (from 2019) term 1 and onwards).

ADAM is the School Management Database System that we use at The King's School West Rand.

Parents of students at the King's School West Rand can login to ADAM to be able to do the following:

- View your child's current report and past reports (Grade 1 12)
- View your child's mark-books with assessment dates and results (Grade 4 to Grade 12)
- View your child's academic progress graphs (Grade 4 to Grade 12)
- View a list of your child's teachers
- View vour child's absentee records
- View previously sent messages
- Update personal details and family information











