He wanted to rescue Israel in order that Israel might be a light to the Gentiles, and he wanted thereby to rescue humans in order that humans might be his rescuing stewards over all creation."

In our modern context, we are not saved from broken people or those who are antagonistic towards us. We aren't saved FROM interactions with those opposite to us but TO them. We are called out to be rescuers to them.
