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From the Chairman of the Board of Directors

Dear Parents

As we approach the end of a tumultuous pandemic year and pause to reflect, we celebrate God's goodness, His faithfulness, His mercy and His loving kindness to us as a school. We marvel at His hand and His timing in all things. Without any knowledge of what lay ahead with regards to the pandemic, Mr Langley showcased the Collaborum platform to the Board in February and shared his vision of growing the platform into something that would be really valuable for our school. The pandemic catapulted us into a teaching situation that we had not planned for but because the groundwork had been laid with the platform, were able to begin to utilize it straight away. For many of the teacher's new skills had to be learned in a very short space of time and while it was very challenging, they rose to the occasion and have excelled in many ways. On behalf of the Board of Directors, we would like to say a very big thank you to the teachers and to yourselves as parents, as we have navigated this unknown territory together.

It is my great pleasure to welcome Mr Clete Stevis onto our Board of Directors. He is passionate about

Christian education and his love for Jesus and the gospel is clearly reflected in his full-time work in poorer communities. Clete is a man who "walks his talk" and the testimony of his life is a blessing to us all.



As a Board of Directors, we are very cognisant of the fact that everyone has felt the economic fallout of the lockdown. By trimming next year's budget wherever possible, we have been able to limit the fee increase to 2% on average (5.1% last year and 5.4% the year before).

We also know that having multiple siblings in the school is a serious drain on finances, and so we have increased the discount for two children families from R800 to R1000 (a 25% discount increase) and for three children families from R1300 to R1600 (a 23% discount increase).

Our school offers the highest discount in the region on fees paid in advance, 7% for fees paid annually in advance before the 31st January 2021. There are also discounts available for 3-month and 6-month advance payments, but these are only applicable if the account is up to date without any arrears.

As we enter the fourth and final term of 2020, and long for things to be "normal" again, I am reminded that even in times of the greatest uncertainty we can be absolutely certain that our lives are in the hands of the One who knows ALL things, controls ALL things and loves His children with an everlasting love. May you experience His peace at this time and echo the words of the Psalmist,

*"The Lord is my light and my salvation –
whom shall I fear?"*

*The Lord is the stronghold of my life –
of whom shall I be afraid."*

5. Hand sanitiser will be available in the shop for Parents and Children on entry and exit of the shop.




Hygiene Guidelines

FOR SWOP SHOP/2nd HAND SHOP

Guidelines for the management of the swop shop/2nd hand uniform shop, based on the principles set out by the NCID in the control of Covid-19.

- Surfaces of the shop to be cleaned with household detergent, then disinfected applied to surfaces before the shop opens.
- All surfaces, including floors to be disinfected at the end of each day that the shop is open.
- Gloves to be used when cleaning the surfaces and handling soiled clothing items. Proper personal hygiene to be followed before and after the use of gloves. Correct disposal of gloves to be followed.
- Parents accessing the school grounds will be required to follow the access rules as set out by the school.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitiser to be used on entry to the shop.
- No mask No entry policy to be enforced.
- Maximum of 2 people to be allowed into the shop at any given time.
- Minimum social contact and a safe distance of 1,5m between customers.
- Parents advised to please bring their own bags or packets.
- Parents are requested to please wash any items brought in for exchanging.
