# From the Principal's desk

Many people feel that they are ill-equipped to pray out loud, but listen to what one of the giants of the Christian faith, Martin Luther had to say about prayer:

**"THE CHRISTIAN PRAYER IS EASY AND IT DOES NOT CAUSE HARD WORK.... IT PRESENTS THE NEED FROM THE HEART. FAITH QUICKLY GETS THROUGH TELLING WHAT IT WANTS. MANY LONG PRAYERS ARE NOT THE WAY. GOD HAS NO NEED OF SUCH EVERLASTING TWADDLE."**

Prayer is a time of taking the burdens of our heart to God and trusting him to work them out, not according to our demands /requirements/expectations, but according to his own perfect will.

As Tim Keller reminds us, when we pray, we will either receive what we ask for, or we will receive what we would have asked for if we knew what God knows.

Finally, a word to our parents. Please, please let your children see and hear you pray, for them, for the world that they occupy, for God's Kingdom to come on earth as it is in heaven. When you pray with your children you build a lasting legacy, and I believe that it will be a legacy that you will only be partly aware of in this life, because of its grandeur and scope. Pray John 17 over your children (the prayer of Jesus for his disciples) where our Lord gives us a pattern on which to ask from our Heavenly Father.
