A few weeks ago when we saw the widespread looting and burning of retail outlets that cost our country billions of Rands, coupled with the peak of a particularly devastating surge in Covid infections and death, there seemed to be an element of despair in every conversation.

For me, in this time of lamentation, I found refuge in Christ, our cornerstone. I love reading up about the origins of worship songs and Reuben Morgan, who penned the lyrics of the modern worship song Christ Alone, Cornerstone, tells an interesting story about its roots.

Morgan was visiting friends in Norway shortly after a mass murderer had shot and killed dozens of people in a shooting spree. He remembers that the despair on the streets was almost palpable, and writes

"We only just have the time to forget the face of the gunman when another chorus of sirens wail. We have barely cleaned up after the flood when an

earthquake strikes... When things start to fall apart, we wonder whether what we have built our life upon is capable of sustaining us... With all the storms and struggles that we face, with the threats and fears that stack up, there is only one thing in which we can put our trust."

Out of this deep emotion Morgan wrote the beautiful lyrics

**Christ alone, Cornerstone
Weak made strong in the
Saviour's love
Through the storm He is Lord,
Lord of all**

Let us continue, brothers and sisters, to lean into Christ our Cornerstone. All authority on heaven and earth has been given to Him and He is establishing His Kingdom.
