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
The matric group of 2021 once again has done us proud.

The 47 young people showed determination and dedication to complete a year, which started off with uncertainty, with flying colours; achieving a 100% pass rate and 59 subject distinctions.


A **100% university entrance** (85% bachelor degree studies) is truly commendable.


