From the Principal's desk

Many people on their deathbed are haunted by thoughts that they have lived a wasted life, that their years have been spent living from paycheque to paycheque and chasing meaningless goals. Do you sometimes wake up on a Monday morning wondering what it's all about? Same old same old, but at least Friday's coming?

Well, God never intended for us to live like that. N. T. Wright, in his new book, The Day the Revolution Began: Rethinking the Meaning of Jesus' Crucifixion, explains that when Christ died for us on the cross, he was not only saving us to eternal life, but he was opening the way for us to live with meaning and purpose in this present world.

"Jesus' death on the cross was not only to absolve us of our sins;" he says, "it was actually the beginning of a revolution commissioning the Christian faithful to a new vocation—a royal priesthood responsible for restoring and reconciling all of God's creation, protecting and shaping the future of the world."

"JESUS DIED FOR OUR SINS, NOT SO THAT WE COULD SORT OUT SOME ABSTRACT IDEAS, BUT SO THAT WE, HAVING BEEN PUT RIGHT, COULD BECOME PART OF GOD'S PLAN TO PUT HIS WHOLE WORLD RIGHT. THAT IS HOW THE REVOLUTION WORKS."

Even among believers, many people have bought into the idea that as Christians we are to survive this terrible world as best as we can. knowing that when we die, we will escape into paradise in heaven. This causes them to withdraw from the world, protecting themselves in isolation and waiting out their days on earth. But, says Wright, "The four Gospels have very little to say about 'going to heaven'. When Jesus talks about the 'Kingdom of heaven', he doesn't mean a place called heaven, but the rule of heaven, i. e. God, coming to birth on earth." We are not meant to live waiting for heaven after death, we are meant to join with God in establishing the rule of heaven on this earth in the here and now

Our emphasis on Biblical Worldview attempts to take all learning experiences as opportunities to imagine how we could use our knowledge to bring God's order into the world. As our graduates go out and practice this in their professions, they will experience the meaning and fulfilment that arises from living in Christ and for his sake. And, in turn, this will cause our graduates to experience the fulfillment of living with meaning and purpose that is greater than themselves.
