#### **Dear parents**

"Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: yet I say to you, that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these...." (Luke 6: 28)

How wonderful it is to greet spring this year without masks on! The flowers are blooming, the weather is warmer and are hearts are filled with gratitude to God for His faithful provision in our schools. As a Board of Directors we are very conscious that rising costs continue to add pressure to families and as such have strived to keep the increase in school fees as low as possible as we compile a budget that will equip the school to provide Excellence in Education to the Glory of God.

We are delighted to inform parents that our fee increase for next year is once again well below the inflation rate and we remain a very competitive price option in the independent school sector in our region. We have also continued to assist families who have multiple children in the school with sibling discounts of R1400 (two children) or R1900 (3 children).

While the cost of education and resources have all gone up, what has been particularly worrisome is the double digit increases on service charges from the City of Johannesburg (CoJ) for rates, water and electricity. In October, the courts will hear an appeal from CoJ to reclassify all schools to "Business" tariffs, an approximately tenfold increase on Rates and Taxes. Should this application be successful, many smaller independent schools will be forced to close or pass the increased costs on to their parents. We believe that we will not need to do this for next year, but would appreciate your prayers in these matters.
