Dear Parents

Welcome to the final term of 2023. In just a short time, all of our Grade 4-12 students will be writing final examinations for the year. At the Parent's Evening next week, I would encourage moms and dads to check in with teachers about areas of growth and areas which need improvement. These discussions should not only be about academic achievement, but also behaviour, social skills, executive functioning, spiritual growth, self-discipline and many others.

Preaching through the Psalms recently, our Pastor Duncan shared two questions he and his wife ask their daughter's teacher at Parent's Evening. He said that after they find out how-many-piece puzzle their child is building and how well she is counting (their daughter is in preschool), he asks, "Does our daughter respect you as her teacher?" and "Is our daughter kind to the other children?".

He explained that the first question is

about authority and the second one is about character. These are two things that they want their child to grow up with recognition of authority and development of character. I love that perspective between academic achievement and Godly values where the Godly values are the most important lasting treasures.

What are the things that you wish for your child as they grow up? What are the things that our Heavenly Father desires for our children?

REPORTS RELEASED 16 OCTOBER

All reports are available to be downloaded from ADAM, by parents who have created an account and are logged in to ADAM.

Parents will also be able to re-download past reports (from 2019 term 1 and onwards).

ADAM is the School Management Database System that we use at The King's School West Rand.

Parents of students at The King's School West Rand can login to ADAM to be able to do the following:

- View your child's current report and past reports (Grade 1 12)
- View your child's mark-books with assessment dates and results (Grade 4 to Grade 12)
- View your child's academic progress graphs (Grade 4 to Grade 12)
- View a list of your child's teachers
- View your child's absentee records
- View previously sent messages
- Update personal details and family information

SIGNING UP FOR PARENTS' EVENING


Once logged in to ADAM, you will see that each of your children have a block with the following:


